Crittenton provides programs and services in a residential setting for pregnant adolescents and adults, teen mothers and their babies who are in the foster care system, and young women who are transitioning out of the foster care system.

Who We Serve

- 54% of maternity clients were homeless at admission
- 98% are Medicaid eligible
- 15% tested positive for drugs at admission
- Survivors of incest, physical and/or sexual abuse, neglect, and family violence
- Foster care adolescents and children
- Resilient women

Outcomes

Maternity Program

The **Maternity Program** is our largest and oldest program that offers access to prenatal and health care, counseling, vocational and educational services, parenting and childbirth education, case management and trauma responsive programming.

- Served 37 mothers-to-be and their unborn children for a total of 2,332 days of care
- 11 babies born
 - 91% born drug-free
 - 80% had birth weights greater than 5.5. lbs.
 - 100% had APGAR scores greater than or equal to 7 at 5 minutes after birth

Sarah's House

Sarah's House is a residential mother-child program that supports young mothers and their children who are both in foster care. Mothers prepare for independent living with a focus on parenting, education, and life skills.

- Served 16 foster care clients (8 mothers & 8 children) for a total of 1,940 days of care

Legacy Hall

Legacy Hall provides Independent Living Skills to adolescent females in foster care. This program helps young women develop educational, vocational, life, and social skills that facilitate positive life outcomes.

- Served 23 clients in foster care for a total of 3,334 days of care

Aftercare Parenting Education Program (APEP)

The **Aftercare Parenting Education Program (APEP)** provides home visitation and continued services for former Maternity and Sarah's House clients as they transition back into the community.

- Served 21 families (50 individuals)

The year *in review*

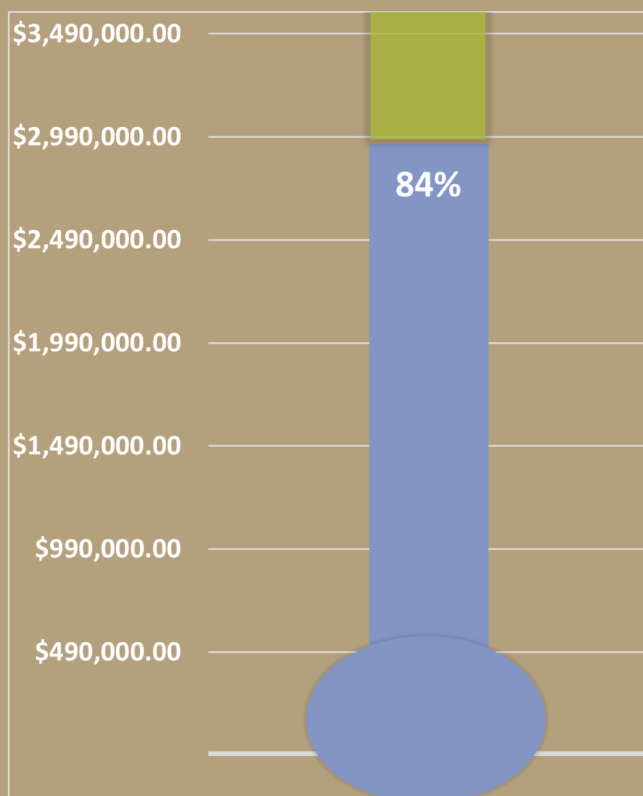
This past year, the women, girls, and adolescents we serve made incredible strides.

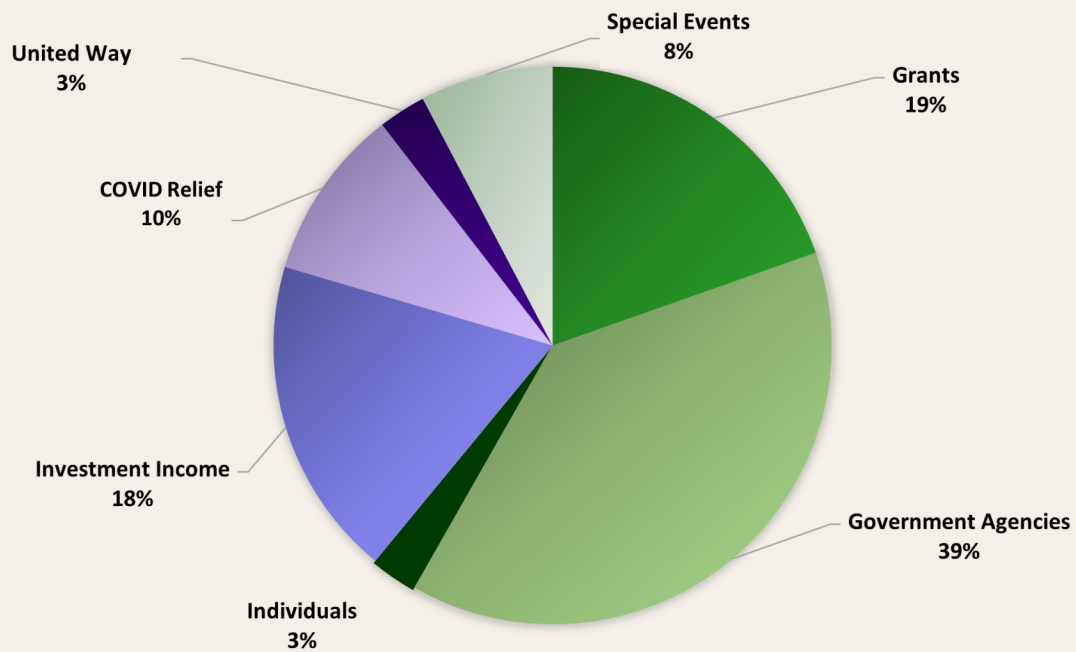
Capital Campaign



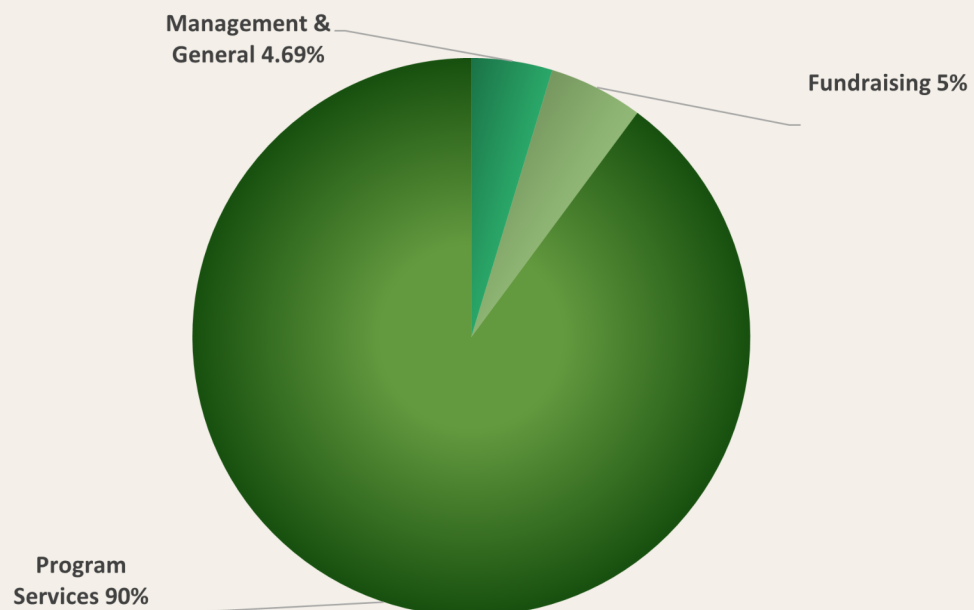
