- Responsible for cleaning all designated areas of the kitchen and dining room, maintaining the highest sanitary standards
- Restock areas on serving line and maintain clean, orderly stockroom and refrigerators/freezers
- Provide exceptional customer service to all clients, staff and guests

- Receive and stock truck deliveries
- Assist with catering on and off-site events
- Assist with maintaining vegetable gardens
- Follow all kitchen procedures to ensure successful health inspections
- Research and implement new and creative ideas for healthy, budget-friendly snacks

Qualifications:
